

The Tower of London was established in 1066. The Castle is spread over an area of 12 acres. Every evening, exactly at 9:53 pm, the ceremony of the keys takes place to lock the Tower Of London.

Where is Tower Of London?

The Tower of London's location was carefully chosen as a post to protect the city. The complex is located along the north bank of the [River Thames](#) in central London, which is in the borough of Tower Hamlets.

Best Time To Visit Tower Of London

London weather is frequently overcast, but usually manageable. Tourists during December and January are sometimes met with snow which can inhibit sightseeing and travel. Summer is a better bet, with more hours of daylight and warmer temperatures.

Tower Of London Hours

During summers, the Tower of London is open from Tuesdays to Saturdays from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm while on Sundays and Mondays it opens from 10:00 am to 5:30 pm with the last entry at 5:00 pm.

During winters the opening time is the same, but the closing time is 4:30 pm with the last entry at 4:00 pm.

The Tower is closed from 24 th to 26th December and 1 st January.

Tower Of London Tickets

You can buy tickets in person, or online or by calling 0844 482 7799. The prices of tickets are revised every year. The current fee slab (w.e.f. 1 st Mar '13 to 28 th Feb '14) is as follows:

Individual Booking: For adults the price is £21.45 while for a child (under 16) the fee is £10.75.

Group (min. 15 visitors): For adults the entry cost is £21.45 and for a child (under 16) it is £10.75.

Family: For up to 2 adults and 3 children, the booking would cost £57.20.
